

## **HYDROCELES**

## **CRITERIA BASED ACCESS**

The CCG will agree to fund a surgical referral where the patient:

• Is aged over 2 years.

## **AND**

Has pain, causing significant functional impairment.

## OR

• In the case of a child, discomfort and/or disfigurement prevents the child from undertaking daily living activities (e.g. the child is unable to fruitfully engage in education).

Significant functional impairment is defined by NHS Banes/Swindon/Wiltshire CCGs as:

• Symptoms preventing the patient fulfilling activities of daily living or Carrying out vital domestic or carer activities.
